PARENT'S CORNER

We believe that, to enable each child to achieve their full potential, it is important to develop and maintain a positive partnership between home and school. The research tells us that when parents are involved in their child's education the child will do better. The MCS Diary is one of the ways in which we inform parents, not just about your Child's works, but also about how you can help us your children to succeed in this world and hereafter.

On joining school after an illness, it is mandatory that the student submits a medical certificate to avail benefit of average marks in an assessment missed. Repeated or extended leave without proper application can lead to child's name being struck off the rolls. Re-admission will only be granted after completion of a fresh admission procedure. An application must be written on a neat, plain paper and not on a ruled sheet. It must be duly signed by the parents and handover it to class master for one day or principal for more than two days. The school diary provided by school is an important mode of communication for the parents, students, teachers, and the school authorities.

Before the new academic session starts, kindly read all the pages of the prospectus and diary with your child to have a proper understanding of the school system. Circulars containing important information for the parents are regularly sent via the diary, WhatsApp, and classroom notification. Similarly, in case you wish to convey important information to your child's teachers, you can use our school diary.

- Kindly ensure that your child arrives school five minutes before the school starts
- Your child must maintain an attendance record of 75% during the academic year, failing which he or she shall not be allowed to appear the Final examination.
- You are not permitted to visit your child's classroom during school hours.
- Please note that no student shall not be allowed to go outside the school premises unless a formal request is submitted by the parent or permission granted by the principal.
- If you wish to meet the principal or teacher in the school, you can send a note in the diary or call for an appointment. Do not walk in directly, we may not be prepared to help you properly.

Note: Please make sure that your child carried the diary, tiffin and ID card every day for ensuring effective learning process.

- Setting your napkins and lunch accessories together in the morning. Helping your mother or siblings to prepare your lunch.
- Be prompt in answering the doorbell and the telephone. Remember to speak politely on the phone and be soft spoken at all times.

- Do not spoil the beauty of your school environment by littering in the classroom, school corridors and school playground. In case you find any litter, don't hesitate to pick it up and throw it in the bin, this is your school.
- When you cross a teacher or a guest in the school corridor, greet them and stand on the left side so that they may pass comfortably.


CARING FOR YOUR VAN/BUS/AUTOMATES

- · Caring for your own belonging and others in the School Van/Bus/Auto that brings you to school is also important.
- In the morning it is important to be punctual while boarding the Van/Bus/Auto because your carelessness can cost others their punctuality.
- When school gets over, take care that your catch your Van/Bus/Auto in time. In case your Van/Bus/Auto leaves without you then immediately report to the front office assistant to make a call to your parents.
- Take care that you do not fight or use abusive language for fellow students in the Van/Bus/Auto or in the school premises. The summary of a hadees goes as follow: 'The Best among you are those who have the best manners and character'.
- Care for your country and society by awareness of safety norm and continuing with your healthy attitude out of school or home.
- While on the road, avoid talking to friends, holding hands or playing in any manner. Racing with one another on the road can be hazardous.

GUIDE TO BE DRESSED AS MCSIAN

- · Come to school every morning in a freshly laundered uniform with clean socks, shoes and handkerchief: nails neatly clipped and well combed hair.
- Two plants with ribbons, scarf colour should match the dress.
- Boys should keep their hair cut simple. No "Spikes cut" or application of gel is allowed.
- No jewellery or accessories are allowed except a simple wrist watch and small earrings (for girls). More than one piercing is not allowed. No make-up is permitted. Mehendi (henna) for a family occasion can be applied only with prior permission from school.
- . All stationary items used by you should also be simple i.e. they should not be fancy or expensive.
- Uniform is an important part of life. It helps children to identify with their school and take pride in it. We should respect it by keeping it neat and clean and wearing it in a proper manner.

- Parents are requested to ensure that their child comes to school in proper uniform in order to avoid negative credits. Kindly make note of the following.
- Place your order for the uniform at school in time to avoid inconvenience.
- Ensure that your child doesn't wear a shabby uniform which seams ripped off or buttons missing.
- The dress must be worn with the school emblem attached to the pocket.
- Kindly mark or label your child's cap/scarf and shoes so that they may be identifiable, if mixed up or misplaced.
- Prescribed uniform (Abaya) for high school girls (for Muslim) (6th -10th) is compulsory.
 A smart turn out is very important for a child's self esteem. Let us help our children wear their uniform with pride and confidence.



MCSian's Health Guide

A healthy body houses a healthy mind. A healthy mind nurtures a healthy soul. The tripod of health means

- Take care of your body. This means you should eat healthy food, drink plenty of water, exercise regularly and catch 8 hours of sleep.
- Take care of your mind by reading good literature and learning to think clearly. Keep your thoughts clean and healthy and rinse them of all ill feelings.
- Feel good about yourself by getting along with others, sharing with and caring for your friends and siblings.

GUIDE TO CODE OF CONDUCTING DURING BREAKTIME

When you proceed for lunch,

- Follow Sunnah and make sure your spread a napkin neatly on your desk before you open the tiffin box to maintain discipline and cleanliness.
- Food should be eaten in small bites and chewed properly for good digestion.
- Wash your hands, as per Sunnah, after you finish you tiffin. Follow the etiquettes of eating and drinking.
- Perform Wudhu Ablution (for Muslim Students) correctly in the right order and according to Sunnah.
- Salah (Namaaz): All boys are highly recommended to perform Salah in the Masjid or in the space provided by the school. Procedding the Salah hall in a queue. Do not fight or shout. Follow all the wajibat obligatory acts and the Sunnah.
- Try your best to concentrate in Salah and make your Niyyah (Intention) very consciously. Maintain silence in Masjid and do remember this Allah's house. Carry yourself elegantly and respectfully.

Note: Namaz and lunch/snack breaks should be used properly and productively without wasting time.

GUIDE TO OBTAINING LEAVE FROM SCHOOL

Leave from school can be obtained by student when he/she is not physically fit to attend school. Kindly avoid taking leave for social functions. In case of a long leave, it is very important to seek prior permission from the principal. An application recording the same should be submitted at the Front Office on a working day during the school hours. In case the child is ill, he/she must stay at home and rest. Do not put other children of infection. The ailing child should not come to school even for an assessment because the child will not be permitted to go come after the assessment.



HOSTEL FACILITY

Separate boys and girls hostel facilities with all basic amenities are available for limited number of students. There is advantage in staying at hostel because of the time they are going to spend with their friends in the academic atmosphere under proper supervision of qualified warden. Staying at the hostel not only teaches them the leadership quality but also widens is out look to wards the society. Besides regular warden, special teachers are also engaged to give them extra push they need to conquer the mental distraction. We have regular visitors from different walks of life to interact with our students to boost their confidence level. With constant supervision under the Administrator, we are providing the best facilities and service required for his studies, moral development, teamwork, leadership qualities and other extra-curricular activities.

Girls: Black Thobe with white detailing, Tracksuit, Nightdress



SCHOOL MEDICAL GUIDE

- The school medical is looked after by a team of qualified doctors. Routine Medical checkup by a team of specialists are conducted in each academic session and the parents are informed if the child needs special medical attention.
- Regular lectures on various communicable diseases are delivered by doctors in order to create awareness and provide guidelines for the prevention.
- It is important for children suffering from any illness to have proper medical care and rest. It is not
 advisable for them to attend school, either for regular classes or for assessments while they are
 unwell.
- The medical history of each student is updated every year through the medical card filled by parents. In case, during any of the sessions, the parents wish to convey any special information pertaining to the health of their ward, they can meet the class teacher to update his/her medical record.
- Every child should be de-wormed at least once every year.
- A student returning to school after suffering from an infections/contagious disease should produce
 a Doctor's Certificate permitting him/her to join the class, subject to conditions laid below:
 Students suffering from the following must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before
 returning to class.
 - Chicken pox: 6 days after the disappearance of the last crop of vesicles.
 - Measles: At least 5 days after the disappearance of rashes.
 - Mumps: Approximately 2 weeks after the subsiding of swelling of Salivary Glands.
 - Conjunctivitis: 5 7 days.


GUIDE TO WITHDRAWAL FROM THE SCHOOL

Those parents who wish to withdraw their wards from the school must submit a written application at the Front Office on a working day during school hours.

- A month's notice must be given before withdrawal.
- Students who leave the school without notice and without clearing their dues will not be entitled to any sort of testimonials (Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate, Bonafide Certificate, Date of Birth Certificate, etc.) from the school.
- Application for school leaving/transfer certificate must be submitted within six months of student's leaving the school. No transfer/school leaving certificate will be granted under any circumstances after that date.










STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS

A strategy involves using a plan of action to achieve a certain goal.

To achieve success you need to use a variety of strategies, such as the ones listed below.

Discuss them with your parents or a teacher.



STRATEGY 1 - Listen Carefully

- In the Classroom, concentrate on what is being said and ignore other distractions.
- · Ask questions if something is not clear.
- Focus should be to learn concepts in the class itself.

STRATEGY 2 - Make Smart Notes

- When you take down notes, see to it that you record key-words in your memory note-book. This will help you learn answers fairly quickly.
- When learning at home, write down only important facts and idea and try to correlate them to familiar things, important dates, colors etc.
- Number the major points in a chronological order.

STRATEGY 3 - Choose the right place to study

- Try to do your work in the same quiet place.
- Ensure that your work place is well lit to avoid tiring your eyes.
- Keep your work space tidy and use a firm chair.

STRATEGY 4 - Be Disciplined and Curious

- Make it a habit to do things in a timely manner.
- Refer additional books to get in-depth knowledge on any subject.
 This will give you a competitive edge.
- Enroll at the local or central library to do quality study.







STRATEGY 5 - Revise Effectively

- A time-table for revision should be made and followed religiously.
- Revise in short bursts; stop when your mind begins to wander.
- Write important points while studying, it helps you memorize and retain better.
 Just reading will not be so effective.



Each student is different from the other, in the way he/she works and plans things. In the opinion of experts, all that we achieve in life depends upon the manner in which each task is done and how TIME is managed.

MANAGING TIME IN THE CLASSROOM

- · Keep books ready before start of any lecture.
- Always have the Diary ready to note down details of important Home-Work/Tests/Exams/Projects.
- Listen to the lecture attentively.
- Underline or write important points in the text book while the teacher is explaining.
- Take down notes as soon as the teacher starts writing on the blackboard.



MANAGING TIME AT HOME

- As soon as you reach home, freshen-up and have a snack.
- Relax or play for a few minutes (30-45minutes).
- Prioritize the work to be done. (Check your Diary for Tasks that are coming due.)
- Do these tasks in session of 45 minutes each and take a 15 minutes break before you start another session.
- Choose the most difficult subject first.
- Tick-off and Date-mark tasks that are accomplished.
- Re-schedule tasks that are left incomplete.
- Reflect regularly on your productivity and the amount of time spent.
